



**Master's thesis project:**

**Autistic traits in developmental prosopagnosia (i.e., “face-blindness”)**

We offer a project suitable for a Master's student for their thesis, under the supervision of Dr. Corrina Maguinness and Prof. Dr. med. Katharina von Kriegstein at the Faculty of Psychology, Technische Universität Dresden.

The project aims to investigate the impact of autistic traits on face-identity processing in developmental prosopagnosia and in typically developed individuals.

The project offers the opportunity to work with existing behavioural data (i.e., participant recruitment is not required), on a novel research question involving a clinical population. Students with a keen interest in cognitive neuroscience research are encouraged to apply.
